Sno Kone Machine Instructions

Important

While it performs best plugged directly into 120 volt power supply, if you must use an extension cord, use a #10 wire cord as short as possible.

OPERATION

1. Set the machine on a table or level surface. Make sure to put the drain hose over a bucket or other area that can accept any draining liquid from the machine. Melted ice and condensation go in to the drain hose.
2. Plug in machine. Using a light-duty extension cord may result in a loss of power to the machine.
*If equipped, turn on the light switch (located on front of cabinet).
3. Turn on the motor button, or for some other models push and hold the motor button.
4. Fill the chute to within an inch of the top with ice cubes. The Sno Kone machine can take ice cubes, rounded cubes, drink ice, or homemade cube tray ice.
5. Push the pusher handle down against the ice in the chute. Apply firm and even pressure to make the best snow (too much pressure will result in snow that is coarse; too little pressure will make the snow mushy).
6. Repeat steps 3-6 until you have enough shaved ice.
7. Scoop out enough shaved ice to fill a serving cone and pump 2-3 squirts of flavor onto the shaved ice. Enjoy!

CAUTION

NEVER PLACE HANDS OR OTHER OBJECTS INTO CHUTE AS SEVERE INJURY WILL OCCUR!!!

CLEANING

1. Wipe all water and any syrup off of the cabinet inside and out.
2. Clean the ladle.
3. Make sure to return the Sno Kone machine clean and with all of the parts in order to be refunded your deposit.
